If you have given us your email address you can check the sub list that is automatically update monthly and sent to you on the first day of each month. If not, you can check the list posted in the vestibule.

...Daylight Savings Time will end on Sunday, November 6 at 2 AM! Clocks and watches should be set back (one hour earlier) before you retire for the night. If you don't remember this time change, you will be one hour too late when you arrive for your scheduled hour.

Thanks & blessings to all who maintain or sustain the Chapel in any way. Our Eucharistic Lord knows who you are.

Hour Coordinators are needed for one nighttime hour, and 6 daytime and evening hours:

1 AM, 11 AM, 12 Noon, 1 PM, 2 PM, 5 PM & 8 PM. Would you consider filling these vacancies? Please call Sue Ticken or any Hour Coordinator listed on the bulletin board to ask what is involved.

If you wish to make a monetary donation, you may use the ‘black box’ in the Chapel or mark an envelope ‘Adoration Fund’ and take or mail it to the Parish Center. If you write a check, please make it payable to: **Adoration Fund of HR.**

Reminders

Do not switch the fan to ‘AUTO’ – it must be left in ‘ON’ position to for proper circulation. Deflectors will be installed soon to eliminate drafts.

Periodically check for missing items in the *Lost & Found box* located under the table in the back of the chapel.

Please arrive a few minutes early so the Adorer you are replacing will not be concerned about leaving on time for their next ‘appointment.’

Do not leave reading material in the Chapel or vestibule. All resources must be reviewed by the Adoration Committee and approved by Fr. Paul. This includes prayers, newsletters, medals, or any other written material. *Unapproved items left by individuals will be placed in the Lost & Found box for 2-3 weeks before being removed and discarded.*
